<p>We will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide an orderly, secure and safe environment in which students can learn and develop. • Ensure that students are cared for, respected and treated fairly. • Inform parents of any concerns we have about behaviour/attendance/welfare. • Ensure that all students are taught well and are given help when required, encouraging constructive use of their talents. • Provide students with textbooks, exercise books and other resources for learning. • Set homework regularly and mark it on time. Form Tutors and Heads of House will check students planners weekly. • Produce a full report and organise an opportunity for parents to meet with their child's teachers at least once each year. • Insist that students are correctly dressed in school uniform or they will be sent home to change. • Listen to and act upon parents' and students' concerns. • Keep parents and students informed about school activities and opportunities open to them. • Inform parents via text by 2.00 p.m. each day if a student is required to attend an after school detention. • Model daily our CARE values of Cooperation, Aspiration, Resilience and Excellence. <p>The school reserves the right to withhold the privileges such as trips, clubs, extra curricular events and activities week if student's behaviour resulted in them being placed on report.</p> <p>Headteacher</p>	<p>I/We will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Support the Academy's efforts to maintain proper order and discipline so that the school will be a safe and secure place for both students and staff. • Encourage my child to respect all staff and other students . • Ensure that my child attends school regularly and on time, informing the school promptly of any reasons for absence. • Value my child's schoolwork and encourage my child to ask for help when having difficulties with it. • Ensure that my child is equipped properly for all lessons (see list in planner). As a minimum this is pen, pencil, ruler, planner. • Make sure that my child is doing homework regularly by checking and signing the homework planner weekly. • Attend Parents' Evening and work with the school to help my child's progress. • Ensure that my child is sent to school each day wearing the correct school uniform or they will be sent home to change. • Inform the school of any concerns or problems that might affect the work, welfare or behaviour of my child. • Encourage and support my child to participate in school events and activities. • Ensure my child attends a "same day" after school detention if required. • Encourage my child to uphold the CARE values of Cooperation, Aspiration, Resilience and Excellence. 	<p>I will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Behave and act responsibly in school. Understand that every pupil is at Shrewsbury Academy to learn and that I have no right to distract others from learning. • Respect all staff and other students and treat them with consideration. • Understand that coming to school regularly and on time is vital if I am to continue learning. • Do my best in class and let my teacher know when I am having difficulties with my work. • Bring the right equipment to lessons (see list in planner). • Do my homework to the best of my ability, hand it in on time and keep my homework planner up to date. • Attend Parents' Evenings with my parents, taking note of any progress made and any action needed for my future progress. • Wear the correct school uniform and take a pride in my appearance otherwise I will be sent home to change. • Tell a member of staff of any problems I am having which they may be able to help me with. • Inform my parents of school events and activities and try to participate in them, making full use of the opportunities open to me. • Attend same day after school detentions if required. • Behave daily according to our CARE value of Cooperation, Aspiration, Resilience and Excellence.
